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Belize's natural and cultural attractions are legion; the longest barrier reef in the Western hemisphere, famous Blue Hole, uninhabited cays, palm garnished white sand beaches, the world's first jaguar reserve, ancient ruins and villages whose flavors and accents range from early European Buccaneer to Maya, Garifuna, and Mennonite.

Adventurers and sportsmen know Belize well, but you don't have to ply the jungles and caves in search of the next Mayan crystal skull to enjoy the best Belize has to offer. You can just kick off your shoes and enjoy a beverage on the beach, or have a full body massage and facial in an air-conditioned jungle lodge. Or, what the heck, learn to scuba dive. Ambergris Caye

Twenty five miles long and a mile wide, Ambergris Caye is the largest of the coastal atolls and is world renowned for vacation delights. Kick back in little San Pedro Town (motto: no shirt, no shoes, no problem) or dive and snorkel the nearby reefs. There's a fleet of charter boats for fishing and sailing, and a cold Belikan on the beach is hard to beat.



Victoria House

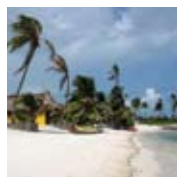
