

## COCOVIEW RESORT ORIENTATION DIVE POLICIES

Every diver on his/her first visit to CCV is required to go on an orientation dive to the Front Yard with a **CCV Divemaster**. There are **no exceptions** to this policy.

On days of arrival, there will be a scheduled dive orientation with a CCV divemaster at 2:30pm, local Honduran time. In order to participate in this orientation, which includes a walkabout on the back dock and a dive out front, the guest must be fully ready to participate.

This means:

- 1) the guest has signed all waivers and registration card and handed them into the office. ( To save time, these waivers can be downloaded from the following link- [http://roatan.com/downloads/ccv\\_waivers.pdf](http://roatan.com/downloads/ccv_waivers.pdf) )
- 2) the guest has presented his/her C-card to the weight room and has checked out weights and room tags.
- 3) his/her dive gear has arrived and is set up in the gear room ready to go diving.
- 4) the guest meets the divemaster promptly at 2:30pm at the night dive sign-out station on the back dock with swim suit and wetsuit on, ready to dive.
- 5) the diver must be in the water by 3:15pm

If on the day of arrival, guests are not able to participate in the scheduled orientation dive for any reason listed above, he/she has the option to pay for a private divemaster to conduct the orientation dive after the 2:30pm as long as the time allows for the divers to be out of the water 30 min before sundown. The cost to the guest will be \$25 to the divemaster who can accommodate up to 8 divers. This cost can be split between the divers and is paid directly to the DM.

Every Sunday morning there is a General Orientation to the resort, followed by an orientation dive led by a CCV divemaster. It is requested that all guests attend the general orientation, and it is required that all divers who have not had an orientation dive, fulfill the orientation dive requirement at that time. Returning guests may dive that morning from the boats. The boats will leave shortly after the General Orientation. The guests new to CCV and who have not yet had an orientation dive will remain upstairs for the dive orientation.

It is best if group leaders wanting to assure that their divers receive an orientation dive the day of arrival, make that request known to the resort beforehand so that the resort can have personnel on hand to meet that request. Email your request to:
